創業夢 = 陳柏基校友



校友陳柏基(Keith)校友自幼深受日本漫畫影響，喜愛創作小說的他，深感華文創作圈理應像當年日本漫畫般百花齊放，大學畢業後他成立「飛天奶茶平台」，連結香港、台灣及馬來西亞的創作人才，立志打造一個始於香港的華文創作圈。

中三那年，陳校友患上骨癌，要停學一年接受化療、物理治療以及切除左腳膝蓋的手術，陪伴他熬過枯燥又孤獨的治療的，是一本本的小說與漫畫。陳校友回想患病期間仍心有餘悸，就在中三的末期考試前一個星期，沒有任何病徵及家族病史的情況下，突然被告知患上第一期骨癌，其後更曾經一度踏進死亡的邊緣。當時他對某款化療藥物引起過敏反應，直接昏迷送往深切治療部。



「真的很突如其來，我心想第一期應該唔會死嘅，有日突然間睇睇下日本漫畫暈咗。我前一秒仲睇緊日本漫畫，後一秒就好似恰著咗然後瞓醒。醫生同我講：『你昏迷咗72個鐘。』當時感覺好震撼。」經過瀕臨死亡的體驗後，正因不知道自己何時死亡，何時會失去寶貴的事物，讓他萌生了創業的念頭：「不如在你未失去之前，就做好你想做的事。」

往後，陳校友努力裝備自己。他於中學畢業後順利升上中大物理系，紛至踏來的事務令其積累豐富經驗，更練就了堅韌的意志。直至大學四年級，他心血來潮在中大成功舉辦「包剪揼大賽」。在獲得「國際包剪揼協會」認可後，他認為時機成熟，是時候開始嘗試創業。於是，他找來三名志同道合的朋友，成立華文創作平台——「飛天奶茶」。



取名「飛天奶茶」，陳校友解釋奶茶乃華人喜好，「香港有港式奶茶、馬來西亞有拉茶、台灣有珍珠奶茶……奶茶就像是國際性象徵符號，令人聯想起華人。至於加入『飛天』二字，喻意想像力能令人飛出天際。」陳校友說平台不會以傳統文學自居，「飛天奶茶發展的是大眾文學，讀者的門檻較低，傳統文學當然有值得欣賞的地方，但卻非我們服務的對象，但平台上的創作人在迎合觀眾口味之餘，也各自有自己的風格，否則很難吸引讀者。」除了從「未來墟」的銷售中分成，飛天奶茶另一收入來源是角色營銷，「我們為企業設計能宣傳公司核心理念的角色，然後為角色創作故事，吸引受眾觀看，從而軟銷企業及其產品，目前已有一間台灣遊戲廠商及香港電腦配件商與我們合作，公司從中收取服務費。」

如今陳校友的癌症已治癒，但左膝的骨頭被永久切除，並換上金屬骨，不能如常人蹲下，走路時亦容易感到疲倦。談到創業心得時，他表示無論什麼時候，人們總有藉口阻止踏出創業的第一步，如需兼顧學業、生活及家庭等，因此他勸喻渴望創業的後輩：「要珍惜光陰，要抱住一個信念——我可能明日會死，不要讓自己在沒有機會的時候才後悔。」

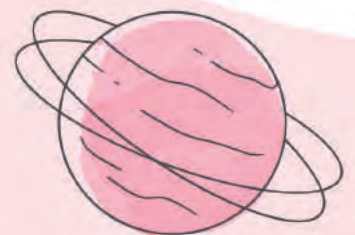
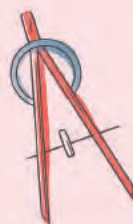
Pink 3D Ting Sin Ki

Blue 1A Lau Tin Sum Tyra

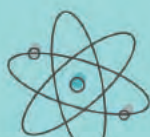
I felt blue today because something had happened.

Looking back at my secondary school years, I doubt if I should really call it "studying." It's not because I didn't invest effort or time. I did. It's because it's difficult to define studying. Under the current system, your academic results don't really reflect how effective you are at acquiring knowledge, but instead reflect how good you are at doing exams. It's cruel but realistic to say that I am not here to help you study efficiently, but rather, how to succeed in this current examination system. I would classify subjects into three categories, not including Liberal Studies, as I am not qualified to speak about that subject area.

As for language subjects, your best bet is to grind for papers until you get consistently good results. I think your actual language proficiency doesn't bear a strong relation to your academic result, especially when the oral exam is cancelled.

For reading, analyze the marking scheme and re-read passages so you can learn to scan for the answers to questions.

For writing and listening, read more well-received passages from given materials, or read the good work of your classmates so that you can figure out the formulae for writing a high-scoring essay.

For math, I am sad to say that you really just have to grind and do all the past papers you can find, as it helps no matter which score range you are at right now. It simply helps. If you are aiming to get a level 3 or 4, you can scout for questions in Part A1 and A2, which have relatively simple questions. Try to get consistently good marks. Don't even bother with those monstrosities in Part B. Focus on what is granted. If you are aiming for a level 5 or 5, drill for the hard questions on topics such as circles, 3-D figures etc. Good luck in achieving perfection. If you are weak in a certain topic, it is hard to get a level 5.*

As for science subjects, it's a lot easier. The most efficient way is to go through one paper and spot which topic you are weak at and then read your notes or textbooks again. As long as you have the knowledge of the subject, you are set for a level 4 or even 5. However, good answering techniques are required for a solid level 5 or 5, so always ask your teacher when you come across difficult questions. Also, study the marking scheme carefully.*

I know how much suffering you are going through right now. Once you have gone through that, a much brighter future awaits you. Good luck and never give up.
