- 5 歷年來，王氏書藝作品，在香港、中國大陸、台灣、日本、韓國、星加坡及美洲各地展出及收藏，均獲好評。
- 6 現任香港大學專業進修學院兼任導師，香港朗誦節中文朗誦委員會顧問委員，全港青年學藝比賽大會永遠榮譽顧問、香港書法愛好者協會名譽顧問、香港書法家協會顧問、香港蘭亭學會會長、香港樂天書法學會會長及香港高齡教育工作者聯誼會名譽會長。

解開近代史之謎?!

中國近代歷史探索行程

2003年12月22日，我校20位「歷史學家」帶著「探索中國近代歷史」的使命前往廣州考察。他們在廣州有何發現呢？現在，讓其中一位「歷史學家」張裕駿同學向大家分享此行的所見所感吧。

在這次「中國近代歷史探索團」中，我們到過十多個不同的景點，如孫中山故

居、中山城、黃花崗七十二烈士墓、近代歷史博物館和陳家祠等，作了一次實地考察和探索，增加了我對中國歷史的認識和興趣。

中山城位於孫中山先生的故鄉翠亨村的北面，是集旅遊觀光、影視拍攝和教育於一身的主題公園。城內有中國景區、日本景區、英國景區和美國景區等。所有景區都反映了孫中山先生革命的經歷。但因時間有限，所以我們只能遊覽日本景區，觀看日本舞蹈和劍道表演，並欣賞了一場北伐軍戰爭表演，場面非常宏大和緊張刺激，真是有身歷其境的感覺。我們還參觀了「劇照館」，那裡除了劇照外，還有一個仿真度甚高的船艙和船隻模型，簡直令人歎為觀止。

陳家祠也是一個令我留下深刻印象的景點。陳家祠建於清代，至今已有百多年歷史；從正門到後門都有優雅的景致，裝飾大多以雕刻為主，造型生動，保存了傳統的建築藝術。那兒還有一幅孔雀刺繡，無論你站在那一方，都會覺得牠的面孔向著你，真是有趣。

黃花崗七十二烈士墓是紀念孫中山先生領導的革命軍在廣州起義失敗，被清軍所殺。當時找到的七十二具屍體便葬在黃花崗。陵墓是用麻石砌成的，而且刻有烈士的姓名給後人紀念；經導遊講解後，我才知道立碑後再找到十一具

第三天：廣州—黃埔—虎門—深圳—香港

早餐後，乘旅遊車前往黃埔軍校參觀學校舊址、參觀完畢乘旅遊車前往東莞，參觀林則徐抗英紀念館。

午餐後，續遊覽東莞虎門炮台，遊畢，乘旅遊車返回深圳，團員轉乘直通旅遊車經黃崗口岸過關進入香港落馬洲，乘原直通旅遊車返回學校。

此外，本校邀得鄭曉春老師在2003年10月在「真情對話：與書本有約」的週會活動中與同學分享她的寫作心得及出版新書的心路歷程。同年12月，本校亦舉行了「一人一好書」巡禮；由老師推介自己所心愛好書，圖書館亦同步展出有關書籍，讓同學先睹為快。

總括而言，從閱讀中學習確實是一件很棒的事情，盼望透過本校多元化的閱讀活動，同學可更投入和享受閱讀中的樂趣。

Sin Tze Ming F.2D

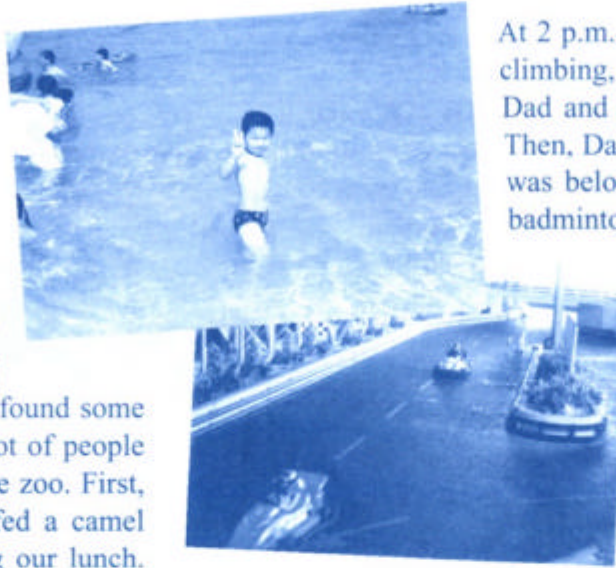
Sunday May 2, 2004

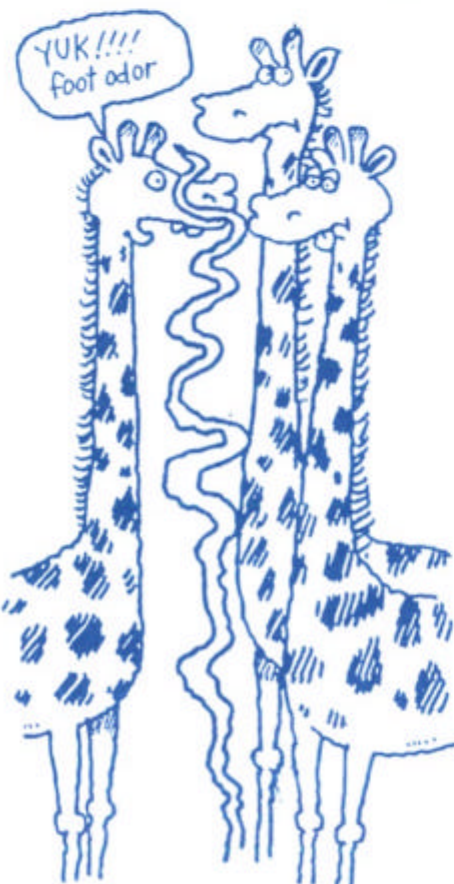
Tomorrow, we will go to the Snake Temple, the jungle and the Monkey Garden. I feel exhilarated.

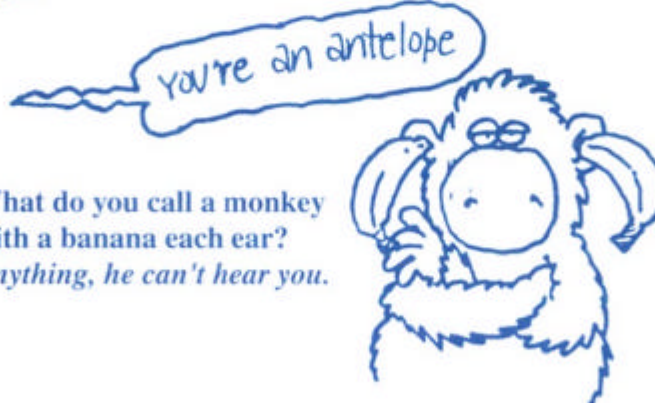

Right now, he also wants to set up a Maths group which will enable him to have a close relationship with his students and to understand their problems better.

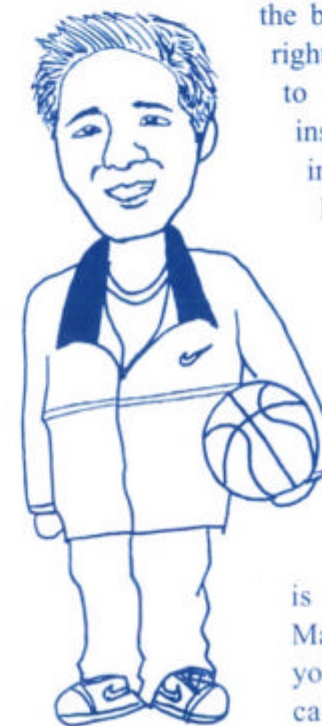
When he grows old, he wants to live in a comfortable place (like Switzerland) where there will be good neighbours and nothing to worry about.
